## Côtes du Rhône White

### GRAPE VARIETIES

- 34% BOURBOULENC
- 33% GRENACHE BLANC
- 33% CLAIRETTE

### TECHNICAL DATA

- Terroir: alluvial clay-limestone terraces and rolled pebbles.
- Manual harvest.
- Aging for 8 months in stainless steel vats.

### TASTING NOTES

A crystalline straw yellow color with a thousand golden tints. On the nose, ripe, sun-kissed citrus fruits; then warm yellow stone fruits are revealed: vine peach, nectarine, very ripe yellow peach and finally some subtle notes of lychee. In the background, we discern more floral notes of white flowers, white roses, hawthorn.

On the palate, a charming balancing act takes place: a three-step sensation that offers a suave and silky texture on the attack, a warmer mid-palate; a finish of a rare freshness, (we almost quench our thirst!). Finally, there is a remarkable aromatic persistence for a wine of this category which assumes a frankly southern character.

Drink within 2/3 years.

### WINE & FOOD PAIRING

Cockles in parsley, Carpaccio of Saint-Jacques, Grilled mussels on the plancha, Fried whiting or Sole meunière will be the perfect companions.
