Technical data :

2 ha (5 acres) grenache and 1 ha (2.5 acres) syrah.

Alluvial sand terraces and rolled pebbles.

Manual harvest in a single day.

21 days of maceration.

18 months aging in concrete vats.

Grape varieties :

70% Grenache

30% Syrah

Tasting Notes :

A purple color and sparkles of ruby. The color is limpid, sparkling and of significant depth. The nose is subtle and complex. A farandole of black fruits where the so-called "Damascus" plum is at the head of the procession. In the second row, we can sense scents of black olive tapenade, and notes of scrubland (thyme, rosemary).

On the palate, the attack is frank and offers very nice acidity while the more suave mid-palate is characterized by a beautiful mineral flavor and its subtle saline notes. The texture is supple and the tannins delicate. The black fruits are more discreet than on the scent and give way to more roasted, mocha notes with a finish that offers fine and noble bitters. A wine that could be confused with certain northern wines due to its airy side. However, the notes of scrubland and southern aromatics are there to remind of a definitely southern character.

Wine & Food pairing :

Veal filet mignon in a spice crust, Aubrac Farm Beef Talaki or even Black Angus fillet with coarse salt and thyme should be remarkable gastronomic companions.
